Black propels Spartans into North Atlantic Conference Semi-Finals.

Castleton, VT-Carrie Black (Warrensburg, NY) was responsible for all 4 goals the fourth seed Castleton State College Spartans netted in Saturday's North Atlantic Conference quarter-final game versus the number 5 Husson College Eagles.

Just five minutes into the game Black assisted on **Carolyn Griggs' (Lincoln, VT)** goal. Not 15 minutes later, Black received the ball at midfield and carried it all the way into the circle for an unassisted tally. The Eagles would not go away quietly, however, as **KaroleAnne Emery (Guilford, ME)** put back her own rebound for Husson's first goal. **Jen Mason (Leicester, MA)** converted on Black's second assist of the half to push the score to 3-1 before halftime. Emery would bring the Eagles to within 1 once again with 18 minutes left to play in the second half. Black would put the game on ice when she converted a Carolyn Griggs assist with 13 minutes left.

Trisha Clark (East Dover, VT) recorded 7 saves to earn the win. Her counterpart, **Kelly Bocchino (Vassalboro, ME)** also stopped 7 shots in the game. Husson ends their season with a 7-9 (4-6 NAC) record. The Spartans advance to the semi-finals with a record of 8-8 (5-3 NAC). Waiting for Castleton in the semi-finals is number one seed, Western New England College, who earned their way by defeating Lasell College 1-0. The semi-final game will take place at Western New England on Tuesday, November 1.
