Kendall propels Spartans into North Atlantic Conference Semi-Finals.

Castleton, VT-After battling a tough wind and an even tougher Lazer defense, Castleton, the top seed in the North Atlantic Conference tournament came out firing in the second half of Saturday's Quarter-Final game. **Lindsey Kendall (Mendon, VT)** found the net twice to lead the Spartans to a 2-0 victory over the eighth seed Lasell College Lazars.

In the 52nd minute of play **Tracy Stala (Nanuet, NY)** gathered in a loose ball on the right side of the goal box, and crossed to Kendall who unloaded a one-touch rocket past Lasell keeper, **Jamie Remmers (West Islip, NY)**. Kendall found the net once again in the 79th minute when a misplayed ball bounced her way in the backfield. She gathered in the loose ball, beat two defenders and slipped the ball past Remmers who came out to challenge.

Kim Allen (Newtown, CT) earned the shut-out victory by stopping 4 shots. Remmers finished the day with 3 saves of her own.

Lasell College ends their season with a 6-8-2 (5-5-2 NAC) record. Castleton advances to the North Atlantic Conference semi-finals with a record of 13-4-2 (10-1-1 NAC). The Spartans will take on the winner of Maine Maritime Academy (#4) versus Husson College (#5) on Wednesday, November 2 in Castleton, VT.
